NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. O'Brien:

On or about October 1, 2016, a discharge of approximately 7,019 gallons of treated landfill leachate effluent leaked from a drywell at the facility. An undetermined portion of this treated landfill leachate discharged to Waters of the Commonwealth (storm water channel to Eddy Creek) in violation of 25 Pa. Code § 92a.1(b).

25 Pa. Code § 92a.1(b) provides a person may not discharge pollutants from a point source into surface waters except as authorized under an NPDES permit.


Please be advised that discharging industrial waste without a permit is also a violation of Section 301 of the Clean Streams Law of Pennsylvania, Act of June 22, 1937, P.L. 1987 as amended, 35 P.S. Section 691.1 et seq. ("The Clean Streams Law"), and subjects Keystone Sanitary Landfill, Inc. to appropriate enforcement action including, but not limited to, civil penalty assessment.

This Notice is for documentation purposes as Keystone Sanitary Landfill, Inc. previously responded to the Department's Waste Management Program in writing on October 6, 2016 pertaining to the spill of treatment plant effluent, its cleanup and the steps being taken to avoid reoccurrence.

This Notice of Violation is neither an order nor any other final action of the Department. It neither imposes nor waives any enforcement action available to the Department under any of its statutes. If the Department determines that an enforcement action is appropriate, you will be notified of the action.
