Enclosed for your record is a copy of the Department's analytical results from the annual groundwater sampling conducted during May 2018. The Department collected samples April 30, May 1, 2 and 3, 2018. Field blanks were submitted each day; results are identified as FB in the report package. The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection's Bureau of Laboratories in Harrisburg performed the analyses.

The volatile organic results identified acetone in all the field blanks and also reported the compound tert-butyl alcohol (TBA) in the field blanks on all days with the exception of May 3, 2018. TBA was reported in two wells on this day, MW-4AR and MW 29UR.
