Learn about Financial Empowerment with the Allstate Purple Purse Curriculum, Moving Ahead Through Financial Management. Julie Yeado and Marleisa Quiles of Sojourner Family Peace Center will share practical tools, resources, and lessons learned from using this curriculum, which offers strategies to address the financial and safety challenges as well as resources to strengthen survivors' confidence in their ability to understand financial fundamentals such as budgeting, saving, building credit and managing debt.
