

# MOSES SHOWS US LAW

EXODUS 19 3/8/2020

Exodus 19:1-8 (ESV): "On the third new moon after the people of Israel had gone out of the land of Egypt, on that day they came into the wilderness of Sinai. 2 They set out from Rephidim and came into the wilderness of Sinai, and they encamped in the wilderness. There Israel encamped before the mountain, 3 while Moses went up to God. The LORD called to him out of the mountain, saying, 'Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob, and tell the people of Israel: 4 "You yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and MOSES SHOWS US brought you to myself...."

"...5 Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession among all peoples, for all the earth is mine; 6 and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation." These are the words that you shall speak to the people of Israel.' 7 So Moses came and called the elders of the people and set before them all these words that the LORD had commanded him. 8 All the people answered together and said, 'All that the LORD has spoken we will do.' And Moses reported the MOSES SHOWS US words of the people to the LORD."

#### MOSES SHOWS US LAW

Galatians 3:19 (ESV): "Why then the law? It was added because of transgressions."



Galatians 3:11 (ESV): "Now it is evident that no one is justified before God by the law, for 'The righteous shall live by faith."



Galatians 3:24 (ESV): "So then, the law was our guardian until Christ came, in order that we might be justified by faith."



Romans 4:24-25 (NIV): "God will credit righteousness [to] us who believe in him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead. 25 He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification."



John 5:24 (ESV): "Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life."



Romans 3:28 (ESV): "For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law."



Exodus 19:10-12 (ESV): "The LORD said to Moses, 'Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow, and let them wash their garments 11 and be ready for the third day. For on the third day the LORD will come down on Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people. 12 And you shall set limits for the people all around, saying, "Take care not to go up into the mountain or touch the edge of it. Whoever MOSES SHOWS US touches the mountain shall be put to death.""

#### THE LAW IS A WALL, AND THAT'S ALL.



Ephesians 2:14-15 (NIV): "For he himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility, 15 by setting aside in his flesh the law with its commands and regulations."



Romans 8:2 (ESV): "For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.



Romans 6:4 (ESV): "You are not under law but under grace."



Romans 3:31 (ESV): "Do we then overthrow the law by this faith? By no means! On the contrary, we uphold the law."



Deuteronomy 19:15 (ESV): "A single witness shall not suffice against a person for any crime or for any wrong in connection with any offense that he has committed. Only on the evidence of two witnesses or of three witnesses shall a charge be established." MOSES SHOWS US 1 Timothy 5:19-20 (NIV): "Do not entertain an accusation against an elder unless it is brought by two or three witnesses. 20 But those elders who are sinning you are to reprove before everyone, so that the others may take warning."



Romans 7:6 (ESV): "But now we are released from the law, having died to that which held us captive, so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit and not in the old way of the written code."



Romans 8:3-4 (ESV): "By sending his own Son...he condemned sin in the flesh, **4** in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us."

Acts 7:48 (NIV): "The Most High does not live in houses made by human hands."



John 15:8-13 (ESV): "By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples. 9 As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love. 10 If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. 11 These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full. 12 This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. 13 Greater love has no one than this, that someone MOSES SHOWS US lay down his life for his friends."

Galatians 5:14 (ESV): "For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."



Romans 13:9-10 (ESV): "For the commandments, 'You shall not commit adultery, You shall not murder, You shall not steal, You shall not covet,' and any other commandment, are summed up in this word: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' 10 Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law."






