This is a light weight and buoyant wine with vibrant berry tones, dark fruit, plum, spice, tobacco and pressed violets. The bouquet is authentic and shapely without being too bold or overly intense. The effect is seamless, with a long and silky line of aromatic descriptors that reach a nice place of unity and harmony. The mouthfeel shows similar integration with refreshing brightness at the back.”

La Poderina’s winemaking philosophy expertly combines winemaking tradition with innovation. From the finest vineyards in Castelnuovo dell’Abate, high quality agriculture and hand harvesting come together to produce controlled yields of Sangiovese Grosso that make up the esteemed Brunello di Montalcino. The wine then rests in a blend of small barriques and large oak casks for at least twelve months, before aging an additional eighteen months in bottle. The result is a beautifully crafted, versatile wine that can be enjoyed now or cellared for decades.
