Harriet Tubman leads Union guerrilla soldiers into Maryland to free slaves.



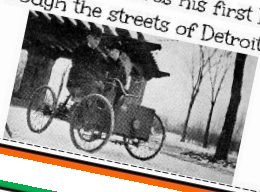

Robert Bunsen invents the Bunsen burner.



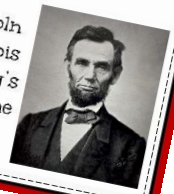
**TODAY IN HISTORY**

Valentina Tereshkova, the first woman in space, returns to Earth.



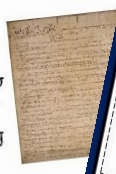
