The desert bighorn sheep was chosen to be Nevada's state animal in 1973.

Desert bighorns are stocky, heavy-bodied sheep that can grow up to 4 1/2 feet tall and can weigh 200 pounds. They are found in Nevada's mountainous desert and can go for extended periods of time without drinking water. Their padded hooves allow them to climb the steep, rocky terrain of desert mountains.
