



DATABASE COORDINATOR

Reporting to the Director of Development, the **Database Coordinator** is responsible for supporting the development department's data processing activities, providing outstanding customer service to members and donors, and various administrative/clerical functions.

Basic Purpose and Responsibilities:

- Maintains and enhances database capabilities for membership and donor base.
- Processes membership, annual fund, tribute, capital campaign, and Zoo Foundation gifts.
- Prepares membership, donor, and capital campaign reports as needed.
- Responds to incoming phone calls and provides information on membership programs and events.
- Assists with preparing direct mail related to membership and the annual fund.
- Prepares donor acknowledgement letters.
- Prepares capital campaign pledge invoices.
- Maintains an accurate database by running monthly reports.
- Assists with inventory, purchasing, and receipt of supplies and printed materials.
- Maintains development and capital campaign files.
- Periodic on-site membership sales.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Director of Development.

Position Qualifications:

Education (Minimum Needed):

- Bachelor's degree or a combination of experience and education.

Experience (Minimum Needed):

- Two years experience in data management.

Special Skills:

- Strong attention to detail.
- Patient, friendly attitude.
- Experience with Raiser's Edge or other CRM.
- Working knowledge of Microsoft Office and Google applications.

Other:

- Must have an appreciation for the mission of the Buffalo Zoo.
- May include some weekends, evenings and holidays.
