Why was Martin Luther fearful of the righteousness of God?

As you've read this book and the Bible readings, what are some of the ways you've seen the Law and the Prophets (the whole Old Testament) bear witness to the righteousness of God?

If we are "Justified by his grace as a gift," how should this change the way you see yourself? How should it change the way you see God?

Are you uncomfortable thinking and talking about God's wrath? If so, do you think this feeling is shaped by Scripture or other influences?

Elsewhere in Romans, Paul writes, "God's kindness is meant to lead you to repentance" (2:4). In what ways have you seen God's kindness lead you and others around you to repentance?
