DESCRIPTION

The goal of the PALS Course is to improve the quality of care provided to seriously ill or injured children, resulting in improved outcomes.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

1. Go to <https://www.cardiosave.com/Admin/CourseSearch> to view the PALS Renewal schedule online and create an online "USER PROFILE" but **DO NOT REGISTER**.
2. Email chscpr@team-ihc.org the following information:
 - Name, email and phone
 - Hospital
 - Credentials
 - Course ID, Preferred Location, Date & Time (step 1 above)
3. The following will be provided once registration is approved:
 - The American Heart Association link for the pre-test.
 - You must score above 70% and bring your printout of the results to your selected course.
 - You will also receive the 2015 ECC handbook by mail.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- Hospitals who are participating in Illinois's Pediatric Facility Recognition Program.
- Healthcare providers who either direct or participate in the management of respiratory and/or cardiovascular emergencies and cardiopulmonary arrest in pediatric patients.
- Emergency response, emergency medicine, intensive care and critical care units such as physicians, nurses, paramedics and others who need a PALS course completion card for job or other requirements.
