

# HOW TO FIND LOCAL SOCIAL SERVICES

This infographic is meant to aid advocates to find local social service agency services, resources, and events. Below are are steps on how to locate the resources you may be looking for.

## 1 LOCATE WI DHS WEBSITE



Go to the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) website [HERE](#). This will list community programs, social service agencies, and human service agencies alphabetically by county or tribe.
