1:1 Orientation will be composed of 2 two week blocks with single attending  
 Cardiothoracic, Obstetric, Pediatric and Regional rotations will have an introductory, intermediate and advanced level rotations  
 ICU will have two introductory months in the CA-1 year followed by an intermediate and advanced rotation in the CA-2 and CA-3 years respectively  
 Acute and Chronic Pain Management will be offered as an introductory and advanced rotation  
 In CA-2 and CA-3 General OR rotation residents will be involved in supervision of junior residents on more advanced clinical cases with attending supervision  
 In Practice Management Rotation CA-3 residents will assist in resident assignment and operating room board running in addition to senior level general operating room cases
