



## **Information for Parent/Guardian Regarding School Orders**

### **For Students with Diabetes**

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We have revised our Diabetes Medical Management Plan (DMMP) and Diabetes Management Plan (DMP) for the 2018-2019 school year. The DMMP is the doctor's orders for the school nurse and the DMP outlines the diabetes care you are requesting for your child.

**The DMMP and DMP are universal forms we provide for our patients and will replace forms provided by individual schools.**

If your child does not already have a Section 504 Plan for diabetes accommodations, we suggest you begin to formulate that with your school staff.

- 1. Please complete all portions of the DMMP based on your child's current insulin doses, and add any additional instructions required. We will review, sign and return via fax to you. Please be sure to include your return fax#. If you do not complete the insulin dose portion of the form, we will complete based on your child's most recent office visit. Return the form to our office via fax (551-996-0115), at least 2 weeks prior to school start. Forms received by our office less than 2 weeks prior to school start may delay your child's admission to school in September.**
- 2. Please complete all portions of the DMP and return to your school nurse along with the DMMP. Do not send the DMP back to our office.**
