Known as the Strawberry Pinnacles, this terrain is home to a remarkable parcel residing in one of the most scenic recreational splendors of Utah. The iconic Strawberry River runs through the land, offering very rare stream frontage in the heart of this highly desirable fly-fishing destination. The best of everything Utah has to offer beckons within the property's mountain splendor, geological features, gin-clear fly-fishing stream, and breathtaking views in every direction. The Riverside Cabins at Strawberry Pinnacles is a unique and unprecedented offering, and it is one of a very few properties along the coveted Strawberry for sale.





LOCATION & ACCESS

Riverside Cabins is approximately 100 miles SE from Salt Lake City, Utah, in Duchesne County. From the I-80/US 40 junction, travel east on US 40, through the towns of Heber and Fruitland, for roughly 64 miles. Turn right onto Red Creek Road (41950 West) and travel south for six miles. Turn right onto Strawberry River/Camelot Road (9980 South) and travel west for 1.5 miles. GPS coordinates for the property are: 40 07' 40.55" N 110 44' 39.42" W. The property is accessible year round.



AIRPORTS

There are four nearby airports. The Duchesne Municipal Airport is 31 miles east of the ranch and is owned by the city of Duchesne and managed by Mr. Richard Ivie (435-738-2464). Fifty-five miles to the northwest in Heber is Russ McDonald Field which features a full-service FBO, providing Jet A and AvGas, aircraft de-icing, large hangars (can accommodate aircraft up to GIV) and an eight acre aircraft parking ramp, rental car and limo services, a pilot's lounge with WiFi, catering, and flight planning. The Vernal Regional Airport is 89 miles to the east and Salt Lake City's International Airport, with service by nine major airlines and approximately 89 nonstop cities in the United States, Canada, and Mexico, is approximately 106 miles away.

NEARBY CITIES & SERVICES

The charming mountain communities of Heber and Midway are approximately 55 miles away and offer a variety of eateries, hotels, golf courses, spas, and a host of winter and summer attractions. The world famous resort town of Park City is 73 miles away.

TERRAIN & WILDLIFE

The property sits at 6,700 feet above sea level in the heart of a beautiful riparian corridor. Three rivers transverse the area: Red Creek, Avintaquin Creek and the Strawberry River. The Strawberry flows directly through the parcel. Steep canyon walls and the stunning Strawberry Pinnacles, visible from the cabins, punctuate the surrounding cottonwood, pine and aspen forest. Wildlife is plentiful. Rocky Mountain bighorn sheep, mule deer, cougar, bear, elk, moose, eagles, hawks and songbirds are all seen on the property.

FLY FISHING

Fishing is, without a doubt, the real gem of this unique property. The Wild Strawberry River is one of Utah's most productive fisheries. Brown, cutthroat and brook trout populations are maintained by natural reproduction in this section of river. It is managed as a wild trout fishery and was one of the first waters in Utah to be designated a "Quality Fishing Stream." It is classified as a Class II fishery (a productive stream with high aesthetic value where fishing and other recreational uses should be the primary consideration). Deep pools, beaver ponds, and undercut banks on this section hold many wary browns from 13 to 20+ inches. Amazing stonefly and green drake hatches occur in June and early July. Terrestrials like hoppers, beetles and cicadas can bring fish to the surface from July on, but bead head nymphs fished as droppers are the most consistent producers in the late summer. The Strawberry is a tailwater, so fishing is stable all year.

OTHER RECREATIONAL PURSUITS

The area surrounding the property offers every form of high mountain recreation and hunting imaginable. The nearby Ashley National Forest is full of trails for hiking, biking, horseback riding, 4-wheeling adventures, and snowmobiling. Strawberry and Starvation Reservoirs, both within an hour from the property, offer uncrowded waters for boating, kayaking, and swimming. Strawberry Reservoir is well known for its large trout and excellent ice fishing.

IMPROVEMENTS: The property includes three small guest cabins. The cabins have been rented year-round by hunters, anglers, and small families and could continue to generate income for the next owner. Each rustic cabin has culinary water and power and features a queen bed, loft, small kitchenette, bathroom with shower, and its own fire pit for roasting s'mores under the stars. There is plenty of room on the property for your RV and your dream cabin--when you're ready to build it.



UTILITIES

Power is provided by Moon Lake Electric Association, a rural electric cooperative located in Roosevelt, Utah. Vernal-based Strata Networks provides local land-line, cell phone, and internet services.

WATER

The property has spring-fed culinary water with rights to supply the cabins. Additional water rights provide water needed for landscaping. Details on the specific rights, which will transfer to the buyer, can be provided upon request.

ZONING

The property is located in an Agricultural Zone with a five-acre minimum lot size subject to county building department approval.
