



WRAPPING ALL THE WAY Costume Instructions

This year each child will be responsible for putting together or purchasing their costume. The costumes will be worn to our dress rehearsal on Wednesday, December 18 and for the performance on Sunday, December 22. Please begin to look at what you have or can purchase before our dress rehearsal and it would be great if you can send a picture to the director in advance.

Most of the children will be "Tunies" in Tuneville – think the Whos in Whoville from "How the Grinch Stole Christmas." This town of Tuneville loves Christmas so much that they celebrate it every day! The basic idea is over-the-top red and green with neutral colors like white, black, gold and silver. The room is big, so large splashes of color and anything sparkly makes more of an impact. I guess I'd say think more whimsical than not.

Girls: Any kind of red or green Christmas dress with striped or solid tights. A shirt and sparkly or solid-color leggings with a tutu skirt would also be fun. Solid color sneakers, dress shoes, or fun socks are okay.

Boys: Red, green, gray, or black pants and colored vests, or suspenders with a bow tie would be fun. Christmas sweaters and flannel/plaid are a good option. Solid color sneakers, dress shoes, or Christmas socks are okay.

Accessories: Scarves, vests, headbands, ribbons, etc.

Please Avoid: Other colors like blue, purple, orange, pink, etc. Not that they can't be present at all, like on a sweater or an underneath layer, but hopefully they are not the main color. I'd also like to stay away from images of people or animals on clothes i.e. no penguins, elves, Santa, reindeer, snowmen, etc. I am okay with images of items like candy canes, snowflakes, stars, peppermints, Christmas trees etc.

If possible, I would love to see your child's costume before December 18. Please send me a picture or bring it to a rehearsal when you have it. ☺
