Housing Financial Assistance

Indiana COVID-19 Rental Assistance Program

Individual households who have experienced a loss of income due to the pandemic may be eligible for rental assistance up to \$500 per month for four months, for a total maximum benefit of \$2,000 per household. Applications will be accepted through www.IndianaHousingNow.org beginning July 13, 2020 at 8:00 AM (Central).

Energy Financial Assistance

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)

A one-time \$350 benefit is available for anyone that has lost their job or significantly decreased their hours since the start of the COVID-19 emergency declaration. This benefit is available to individuals that have received energy assistance already and those that have not applied yet but meet the household income requirements.
