

Visual Arts Writing Ideas

1. After watching the video, summarize three key ideas that you learned. (3-12)
2. After watching the video, did you learn things that didn't fit with what you thought about how art is created is made or how what you already knew reinforced? Do you have new insights into the producing of a show? Write two paragraphs to answer these questions. (5-12)
3. Describe where you think ideas or inspiration for art comes from. What do you think is most important for artists when creating a piece of art? (6-12)
4. Research different types of media, for example, watercolor, oil, charcoal, pastel, sculpture, collage, ceramics. Pick 4 types and describe what an artist does to create in this media.
5. Argue that a piece of art means different things to different people. What are the views, attitudes, intentions that are artist may be communicating? (9-12)
6. Choose a piece of artwork and describe what you like and dislike. (3-12)
7. Explain why a piece of advice that has been given to beginning artists is that artists should have thick skin and be stubborn. (6-12)
8. Pick two artists and compare and contrast their work. (9-12)
9. Define aesthetics and what it means when looking at art. Who decides what makes artwork valuable? (9-12)
10. Research and artist and study how his/her art has changed over time.
11. Choose a particular art medium and research the tools that are used to create that art.
