



REGISTER TO VOTE

If you are not sure if you are already registered to vote you can go to <https://lookup.boe.ohio.gov/vtrapp/summit/vtrlookup.aspx> and enter your first and last name to check your status.

IF YOU ARE NOT REGISTERED TO VOTE

You can register to vote by completing the Voter Registration Form (attached) and mailed to the Summit County Board of Elections, 470 Grant Street Akron, OH 44311 or you can register online at <https://olvr.ohiosos.gov/>. To register you will need to provide the following:

- Ohio driver's license or Ohio identification card number
- Name
- Date of Birth
- Address
- Last four digits of your social security number

HOW DO I VOTE?

There are three ways you can vote:

1. In person

- You can report to your polling location from **6:30am – 7:30pm on Tuesday November 3, 2020**
 - To check where to go you can search by your address at <https://lookup.boe.ohio.gov/vtrapp/summit/pollfinder.aspx>
 - If you would like to skip the lines you can vote early at 500 Grant Street Akron, OH 44311 beginning **October 6, 2020** and ending at **2:00pm on November 2, 2020**

2. Absentee

- **All registered Ohio voters whose information is up to date can request an absentee ballot.** You can vote early, from your home and skip the lines on Election Day.
- An absentee ballot can be requested 90 days before an upcoming election

3. Remote Ballot Marking System

- A remote ballot marking system is available through the Summit County Board of Elections for use by an absentee voter with a qualifying disability under the ADA to allow a qualifying voter to mark his or her ballot privately and independently. Individuals can use assistive technology to mark their own electronic ballot.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

1. Complete the absentee ballot. You may have received one in the mail or you can go online and complete a request form at <https://www.ohiosos.gov/elections/voters/absentee-ballot/>
2. Print and sign the absentee ballot request
3. Mail to 470 Grant Street Akron, Ohio 44311
4. Wait to receive your ballot in the mail from the Summit County Board of Elections. You can check the status of your Absentee Ballot by calling or online at <https://lookup.boe.ohio.gov/vtrapp/summit/avlookup.aspx>
5. Complete and return your completed ballot. There are two ways:

By Mail:

- Mail to 470 Grant Street Akron, Ohio 44311
- If you return your absentee ballot by mail it must be **postmarked no later than November 2, 2020 and received no later than November 13, 2020.**
- If you are returning your voted ballot by mail during **the week before November 3, 2020, you should take it to the post office no later than November 2, 2020.**

Drop It Off:

- You or a representative can deliver your absentee ballot in person to 470 Grant Street Akron, Ohio 44311

- Absentee Ballots must be **received prior to 7:30pm on November, 3rd**

REMOTE BALLOT MARKING SYSTEM

1. If you are a qualifying voter and wish to request an absentee ballot and use a remote ballot system to mark your ballot, complete the following:
 - Fill out the request form at <https://www.sos.state.oh.us/elections/voters/11-g/>
 - Press the “Download & Print” button at the bottom of the page
 - Open the downloaded file and verify your information
 - Print the downloaded document, sign, put the completed form in an envelope with the correct postage and mail it to **470 Grant Street Akron, Ohio 44311**
