Job Summary

Young Audiences is seeking enthusiastic, hardworking athletics teachers to serve as part-time Athletics Teachers for its After School Arts and Learning Academy operated in partnership with Baltimore City Public Schools. Athletics Teachers will supervise and lead 30 minute classes teaching a variety of sports and physical activities. Athletics Teachers may also organize additional sports and physical education events or competitions on site within the program.

About the After School Arts Academy

Baltimore City Schools After School Arts and Learning Academies, operated by Young Audiences Arts for Learning Maryland (YA), will be an action-packed, after school program that introduces students to a wide variety of art forms – from illustration, to spoken word, to percussion, to drama and dance—and gives students a chance to work alongside their peers and be taught by professional artists. Literacy and math classes will be co-taught by a teacher and professional teaching artist allowing students to experience reading, writing and math like never before...through the arts! Students will have the opportunity to imagine, create, and express who they are through the arts and try on art forms they never imagined. Student's work will be celebrated through a student showcase and family night at the end of the program.

Compensation

- This position works as an independent contractor on behalf of Young Audiences of Maryland.
- The base pay for athletics coaches is paid hourly at a rate of \$34.23/hour. Hours will be tracked for all PD, Planning and Program Days. The hourly rate is an average rate and is calculated using \$25/hour for PD and Planning Time and \$35/hour for actual program days. The pay breakdown below outlines the calculations and total number of hours.
