ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS



Online Master of Arts in Counseling Degree

- A bachelor's degree (or higher) from a regionally accredited institution.
- Completion of Abnormal Psychology and Developmental Psychology courses (or their equivalencies) at the undergraduate level. Applicants who have not completed these courses upon application can be accepted without provision, and will need to either complete UND's Foundations in Counseling course through the master's in counseling degree program, or these two courses prior to beginning their first term.
- An overall grade-point average (based on 4.00 scale) of 2.75 or higher in an undergraduate degree program or at least 3.00 for the last two years of undergraduate work.
- Submission of a two- to three-page personal statement outlining your goals
 and objectives for seeking the Master of Arts in Counseling: Community Mental
 Health Counseling, including your academic or professional accomplishments
 as well as your career goals.
- Submission of written responses to interview questions on application forms.
- Submission of three letters of recommendation (professional letters not from personal relationships or therapists) from those who can comment on your academic abilities.
- Submission of a professional resume.
- An online interview (via web conferencing) with program faculty may be required as a means of clarifying your relevant experiences and/or academic background.
- \$35 non-refundable application fee.
