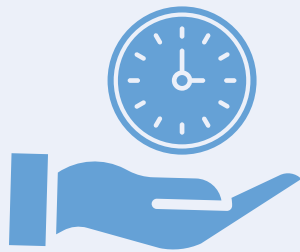


BE A PART OF THE IMPACT IN 2020-2021

Advocacy

Women of Tocqueville have championed advocacy, since the introduction of United Way's *Give. Advocate. Volunteer.* call to action in 2008. Since then, **half of all advocates** that have met with elected officials at the U.S. or Texas Capitol **have been members of the Women of Tocqueville.**




Volunteer Engagement

Women of Tocqueville have contributed **462 volunteer hours** to advance education income and health outcomes, with a focus on kindergarten readiness, mentoring for college prep, strengthening 3rd grade reading level success, and supporting the mental health and wellness of seniors in assisted living facilities during COVID-19.
