Not able to shop? Give VISA gift cards of \$25 increments for older children and place them in the Share Joy gift box at C3 on Sundays throughout November. Target and Amazon gift cards are also happily accepted. Be sure to write the gift card amount on the card with a Sharpie.

Make an online cash donation. Donations can be made online through the Realm. Just select the MISSIONS GIFTS fund and then type in the memo line: DCS CHRISTMAS. If you would prefer writing a check, write DCS CHRISTMAS in the memo line. Please make all cash donations by November 29th.

Give \$10-15 gift cards to McDonalds, Starbucks, Baskin Robbins - places within walking distance for FrankTown Kids. These can also be placed in the Share Joy gift box at C3 on Sundays throughout November. Be sure to write the gift card amount on the card with a Sharpie.
