Thank you with all my heart for the dear, dear letters, the gifts and the vitamins that I am so happy to get! Thank you a thousand times for everything you are doing for me! Many greetings and kisses for mother - from your faithful daughter-in-law, and sister-in-law Mildred.

A jacket and 1 skirt of mine are at the branch of Spindler's at Kurfurstenstrasse 73 (cleaner's) Shoes (old blue-black) at Salamander, Berlinstrasse near Bayrischer Platz. Towards Kaiserallee (registration office) Grey suit at Odelrecht, Tauentzienstrasse at Memorial Church (minor alterations) There are vitamins and yeast that I could well use in the kitchen in Bad Saarow, Kirchplatz 2, and in the kitchen of the Berlin apartment At the top of the pantry in the Berlin kitchen and also in the dresser (bottom) in the hallway near the door.
